

Cairns SLSC Code of Conduct for Members

Aim: - The aim of the policy is to provide clear instructions for all Members and Staff on their obligation with complying with the following Codes of Conduct. **Responsibility:** - Cairns SLSC Board.

Individual Members shall:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others.
- Be ethical, fair, equitable, considerate, courteous, and honest in all dealings with others.
- Be aware of, and maintain an uncompromising adhesion to, SLSA standards, rules, regulations, and policies.
- Raise concerns arising under this policy through the appropriate channels and report any breaches.
- Be professional in and accept responsibility for actions.
- Provide a safe environment for the conduct of activities.
- Ensure that CSLC is an inclusive organisation that is open to all who wish to participate regardless of age, gender, disability, cultural and linguistic backgrounds, or sexual orientation.
- Strive to be a positive role model.
- Use facilities and equipment for their proper purposes, and care for and maintain such facilities and equipment correctly.
- Respect and protect confidential information obtained through surf lifesaving activities or services.
- Maintain the required standard of accreditation and/or licensing as applicable to their roles.
- Maintain a duty of care towards others.
- Refrain from anything which may abuse, intimidate, or harass others.
- Preserve and protect the standing and reputation of the Association.
- Understand the consequences of any breach of SLA's Member Protection Policy or Codes of Conduct.
