BONNIE HANCOCK

On Wednesday 19th June club members Lacey Taylor, Lily Young, Maycee Donovan and Abby Bissett along with other NQB club members were put through a training session with Bonnie Hancock on Palm Cove beach.

For those unfamiliar with Bonnie here is a little about her: A professional Iron Woman by age 17, Bonnie Hancock has competed in seven Nutri-Grain Iron Woman Series and represented Australia in surf lifesaving.

In 2022 Bonnie Hancock broke world records when she circumnavigated Australia by surf ski in 254 days – a feat that saw her treated for hypothermia, fatigue and dehydration along the way. By the time she had completed the 12,700km paddle, she had raised \$65,000 raised for the mental health charity Gotcha 4 Life.

The girls reported the session was both informative & brilliant and are looking forward to putting their new skills to the test.

Tonight, Thursday 20th June at the NQB Office Smithfield the SLSQ Women in Lifesaving Roadshow with Bonnie Hancock kicks of at 6pm until 7:30pm. This is open to females over the age of 14. During the session Bonnie will be signing her book "The Girl Who Touched the Stars"


