Hamish), and a bronze (Abby), with Cairns's competitors placing in the top 8 in most events throughout the weekend.







It was also great to catch up with some former members who have since moved south and joined Northcliffe SLSC. It is always wonderful to see the strong connections that surf lifesaving creates.


