Cairns Surf Life Saving Club Expression of Interest (EOI) Powercraft Officer Role

The Cairns Surf Life Saving Club is seeking expressions of interest for the position of Powercraft Officer. The powercraft officer is responsible for all motorised lifesaving and competition gear, including storage and maintenance.

The Powercraft Officer will:

- Maintain and arrange the service of the club's IRBs, SSV, RWC, motors, trailers and associated equipment required for patrols, education, training and competition.
- Ensure that powercraft are ready and fully operational for patrol, water safety, education, training or competition.
- Ensure there is an adequate supply of petrol, oil and lubricants on hand, correctly mixed, labelled and stored in a secure and safe manner.
- Ensure proper storage of powercraft equipment in a secure location at the club and the equipment is easily accessible in time of need.
- Assist the CTO in instructing members on the use of powercraft.
- Ensure that logbooks are maintained.
- Comply with SLSA/SLSQ procedures related to powercraft.
- Implement and maintain safety protocols for powercraft operations, including risk assessments and emergency procedures.
- Serve as the primary point of contact for all powercraft-related matters, communicating effectively with other club members and staff.

Key Qualifications:

- Be a current, financial member of CSLSC.
- Be over 18 years of age.
- Working with Children Check (Blue Card) or willing to obtain.
- Hold a Silver Medallion IRB Driver award.

Interested candidates are invited to submit an Expression of Interest by 30 May 2025, including the following:

- A cover letter outlining your interest in the role, and how your experience aligns with the responsibilities of Powercraft Officer.
- Any additional supporting documents that demonstrate your suitability for the position.
