Skills Maintenance this year was different to previous years but seems to have been largely seen

as really positive. With the new Lifesaving CPR being rolled out, people were positive about the way the new CPR process works and everyone having a role. Next year I intend on running some skill refresher activities, focusing on areas where we might need a bit more practice, including ART holders use of oxygen, and board rescues.

One of the exciting things from 2025 was that we have a growing team of Trainers and Assessors. In 2025, nine people have begun the process to become qualified trainers. This is HUGE! I am hoping that over the next 12 - 18 months we will have more than 10 qualified trainers and/or assessors in the club. This means better training outcomes for our members, with the education load being spread across more people, with more depth in experience - nurses, paramedics, police officers, teachers, university lecturers, experienced lifesavers - all bringing their own skills and knowledge to support our members. This team will build long-term capability for our club, and I thank them for stepping forward to help.

I am currently building the training calendar for 2026. It will be complemented by courses being run at Branch as well. We have the Club Drone course coming next year again and we will also be getting more people through the Jetski (RWC) course. All the usual courses will be run as well.

As we get into the off season, and take time to refresh, I ask everyone to think about what course you would like to do next year - I've got a Santa sack full of awards for everyone! Make a New Year resolution and email it to me! The more award holders we have on our patrols, the less reliance we have on a small number of people.

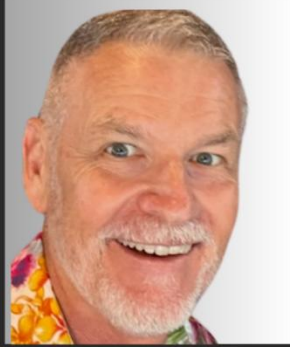
